3D Faith Review

1. 3D Faith: Conformed (Romans 8:28-29) In practical terms, what does being conformed to the image of Christ look like in our lives today?
2. 3D Faith: Make Disciples (Matthew 28:18-20) What is a disciple and how do we go about “making disciples”?
3. In verse 20 Jesus says, “And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” How does this promise encourage you to “go and make disciples”?
4. 3D Faith: Discover (John 1:35-46) What’s the difference between *knowing about* Jesus and *knowing* Jesus? How do we get to know Jesus more? What are the benefits of knowing Jesus better?
5. 3D Faith: Deepen (Matthew 4:18-22) After Jesus extends his invitation to, “Come, follow me,” he says, “I will make you...” In the New Living Translation he says, “I will show you...” What does this tell you about Jesus?
6. How does knowing he’s going to help you “fish” impact his call to you?
7. 3D Faith: Deliver (1 Thessalonians 2:1-8) Other than speaking, in what ways can we share God’s blessings to benefit others? How have you been inspired to “go and tell”?
8. What new discoveries did you make – about God, yourself, your faith – during the 3D Faith series?
